Educational Trusts & Charities

Trusts and charities are sometimes able to help home students with small sums of money towards the costs of education and training, or to support students while they are studying.

This leaflet gives the addresses of some of the trusts and charities. All have limited money and ever growing demands on them. To stand any kind of success you must send a carefully filled out application form, which must be requested from each individual charity.

Trusts and charities can usually help with small amounts of £70 - £300. When making an application, the student must show that they are doing everything they possibly can to help themselves raise the money - by working, asking relatives for support, cutting costs, etc.
