The team can help students with issues such as:

- **Welfare benefits**
- **Housing/Homelessness**
- **Learner Support Funds and other sources of funding**
- **Childcare**
- **Immigration**
- **Domestic violence/forced marriage/leaving home**
- **Advocacy and referrals to specialised outside agencies**

Monday - Thursday: 9.30am - 12pm or 2pm - 4pm

Drop in sessions run from: 12pm-1pm

Friday is usually set aside for meetings and administrative purposes. Students would need to contact the reception to access an adviser.
