- *Designed for students who complete Introduction to Skills 4 Work and/or Move On 1 or 2 and want to continue at college part time*

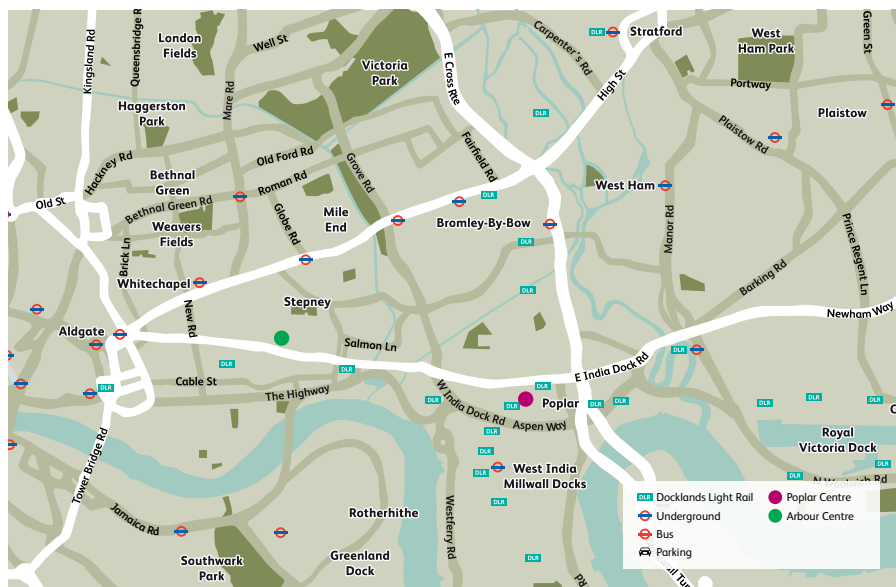
